

Director's Note, by Charity Robinson

This show has been in my head for years. I was blessed enough to be in the show years ago. I have loved the music from the first time I heard it. *I Am Changing* is my all-time favorite song. It tells of the resilience of a woman. And how we pick ourselves up and keep going. However the most well-known song is the iconic, and emotional, *And I Am Telling You I'm Not Going*.

Dreamgirls' original Effie, Jennifer Holliday, earned a Tony for her performance. Her recording of the song hit number one on Billboard's R&B chart in 1982, and she earned a Grammy for the recording the following year. Twenty decades later, it became a hit again, this time for Jennifer Hudson, who played Effie in the 2006 film version. The song resonates with anyone who ever experienced heartbreak; it is a woman baring her heart and refusing to give up on her dream.

Directing this show has been a dream of mine for a very long time. It was originally slated for production in August 2020, but Covid derailed our plans before the season was even announced. I was heartbroken. But just like Effie, I was not going anywhere.

For those of us in the theatre, it often resembles a bad relationship. We invest our heart and soul without reservation each time a new love comes along. We give it our heart and soul, knowing all the while that it won't last forever. We know our Curtis is leaving at the end no matter what.

I refused to give up on my dream of seeing this show onstage; I told myself that I was not going. Although things were changing it was still I knew that there would be a way. And now, two years after I'd planned on it, here it is at last. This time around was hard, theatre in the time of Covid is a different adventure. But we are back, and like Effie, we hope you will love us.
